We expressly agree to defend and hold harmless the Engineer and any of its officers, shareholders, partners, members, or employees from and against any claim, loss, damage or action related to Owner's insurance and bond requirements, including the Engineer's involvement with preparing or specifying such insurance and bond requirements, or to any determination or decision regarding insurance coverages and limits for the Work or the Project.
